ELIGIBILITY:

Students eligible for this program must be a member of a federally recognized tribe or have a CDIB card or agency letter.

SERVICES PROVIDED:

1. School Supplies - At the start of school or when the student is placed on Grove's JOM program and as needed throughout the school year.
2. Senior Caps and Gowns
3. ACT/SAT Assessment Fee Reimbursement - One reimbursement each year for JOM sophomores, juniors, and seniors.
4. Incentive Awards
5. Science Fair Proboards for 5th, 6th, 7th, & 8th grade participants
6. Vocational Class project supplies that are required for participation (Tech Ed. FCCLA classes, Vo-Ag classes)
7. Student Travel Expense Money - contact me for more info.
8. Vocational Program Club Dues are eligible for reimbursement - no class dues.(FFA, FCCLA, HOSA, BPA, FBLA, TSA, & VICA)
9. Student periodical fees for Elementary JOM students
10. Cultural competitions sponsored by our Cultural Resource specialists, Lisa Thorpe at all elementary schools and Joan Spade at the middle school. Lona Hampton also assists with middle school. Mrs. Thompson sponsors the high school.
11. Parent Committee Training and Community Involvement Expenses
12. Sponsors & Bus Drivers fees for Cherokee Nation JOM activities.
